



VISITING SCHOLAR LECTURE OLIVIA GUDE

The University of Florida's Art Education Program is pleased to announce that noted art educator **Olivia Gude** will deliver a public lecture on Friday, January 20, 2012 in FAD 105. Gude is a Professor at the University of Illinois at Chicago and Founding Director of the Spiral Workshop. Gude was awarded the National Art Education Association's 2009 *Lowenfeld Award* for significant contributions to the field of art education.

Gude, a public artist and Senior Artist of Chicago Public Art Group, has created many mural and mosaic projects, often working with inter-generational groups, teens, elders, and children. She has received many commissions and awards, including two *National Endowment for the Arts Art in Public Places* grants. She frequently presents lectures and workshops at universities and museums on the transformation of art education and on her collaborative public artwork.

Gude has served as the keynote speaker for art education conferences in Florida, Illinois, Michigan, Minnesota, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Wisconsin, and Utah as well as for the Manitoba Association for Art Education and the Canadian Society for Education through Art conferences in Ontario and in British Columbia.

Her talk is titled "***Aesthetic Investigations: Developing New School Art Styles.***" For our online students the lecture will be streamed live that evening and be available for viewing online later on. In addition to her public lecture, Gude will offer a full-day workshop for UF art education students on Saturday, January 21 in Norman 10.
